

#### Who is most at risk

Adults who depend on others for their support and care and children and young people under 18 are the most at risk of being abused or harmed by someone they know.

#### Tell someone you trust

If someone is doing something to you to make you feel unsafe or uncomfortable, or you are worried for someone else, tell someone you trust. This can be a member of BCHA staff, the manager of the service where you live or someone from another agency, such as a social worker.

# BCHA will take everything you tell us seriously

We will agree with you what to do next, but if someone is in danger or at risk – such as a child or an adult with needs for care and support – we will have to share this with social services and, in some cases, the police as well.
